Last year, our participant was in a residential drug treatment facility when one of People USA's Care Coordinators assisted him in connecting with a housing program.

The participant has continued to be active in the NA/AA community and has a strong support system that he has built through his positive interactions. He is now working on obtaining his driver's license to further his independence.

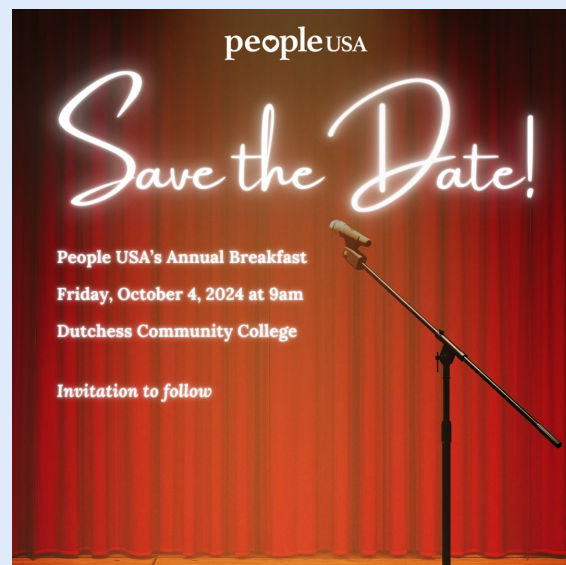
